## Hurricane Frances: Saturday suspension of retail and delivery at post offices with ZIP Codes beginning with 321

Postal officials in North Florida announced the temporary suspension of delivery and retail services at post offices in the predicted path of Hurricane Frances.

All post offices in areas with ZIP Codes beginning 321 will suspend all retail and delivery services at close of business today. These post offices will reopen Tuesday, September 7. Monday is Labor Day, a federal holiday.

Because Hurricane Frances is expected to disrupt mail processing and transportation throughout Florida, postal customers should expect some longer-than-normal transit times. Postal Officials explained that along the storm's path all air and surface transportation will come to a stand still. Plans are in place, however, to use the Postal Service's transportation and processing capacities to the max to keep Frances' effects to a minimum.
